

After a Master's degree and a PhD in cellular biology and physiology obtained at the University of Burgundy in Dijon (France) under the supervision of Pr. Pascal Degrace, I joined the laboratory of physiologic studies led by the Pr. George Kunos at NIH. I mostly worked on the impact of macrophages-expressed CB1R on the development of type-2 diabetes, its renal complication and the development of hepatic insulin resistance. Late 2017, I moved back to France as a "Chargé de Recherche" INSERM in Dijon, France. My goal there is to develop a new research program aiming at unraveling the molecular mechanisms underlying the immunometabolic effects of macrophages-expressed CB1R during the development of diabetic dyslipidemia.
